Introduction

The European Union is protecting the fundamental right to privacy for every EU resident with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which will be effective from 25th May 2018. EU residents will now have greater say over their personal data and how it is used and held.

NFT Group's Commitment

At NFT, we have always honoured data privacy and protection alongside having secure ways of working. We have no need to collect and process users' personally identifiable information beyond what is required for the functioning of our business.

We recognise that the GDPR will help us move towards the highest standards of operations in protecting all affected data.

How is NFT Group preparing for GDPR?

The NFT Group is gearing up to be GDPR compliant across all of its business, by the time the regulation comes into effect. We have analysed all the GDPR requirements and have a dedicated team focused on delivering compliance.

Some of our key initiatives are:-

- **Identifying personal data** - Defining personal data and documenting the various sources of data provides us with a roadmap for compliance.
- **Providing visibility and transparency** - The most important aspect of GDPR is how the collected data is used. As a data controller and

processor, the NFT Group's key role is to effectively manage and protect data.

- **Enhancing data integrity and security** - Data privacy and data security are two sides of the same coin. As our customers tighten their data security requirements, the NFT Group will help. We are streamlining our processes and updating IT policies and procedures to provide even more end-to-end security.
- **Portability and transferability of data** - GDPR gives end users the right to either receive all the data provided and processed by the controller or transfer it to another controller. This is dependent on technical compatibility. The NFT Group is working on further enhancing its data management capabilities to enable export at the individual level.
